- Champion practice that promotes equality, diversity and inclusion and supports human rights and dignity.

Consequences of unacceptable behaviour

Unacceptable behaviour will not be tolerated and actions will be taken if required. Anyone who does not adhere to this code of conduct will be asked to cease any inappropriate behaviour and will be expected to comply immediately. If a participant engages in unacceptable behaviour, the event organisers may take action they deem appropriate, up to and including expulsion from the event.
